Richard Shusterman is the Dorothy F. Schmidt Eminent Scholar in the Humanities and Director of the Center for Body, Mind, and Culture at Florida Atlantic University. Educated at Jerusalem and Oxford, he is author of numerous books, several of which have been frequently translated, including Pragmatist Aesthetics (that is published in fifteen languages). His books in Polish are: Estetyka pragmatyczna: Żywe piękno i refleksja nad sztuką, Praktyka Filozofii, Filozofia Praktyki, Od poetyki hiphopu do filozofii somatycznej, Świadomość Ciała: Dociekania z Zakresu Somaestetyki, and Myślenie ciała: Eseje z zakresu somaestetyki. The French government honoured him as a Chevalier de l'Ordre des Palmes Académiques for his work in the philosophy of culture. His recent book of philosophical fiction, The Adventures of the Man in Gold, is based on his work in performance art, while his research in somaesthetics is nourished by his somatic professional training and practice of the Feldenkrais Method.
