In accordance with the provisions of § 9, item 2 of the admission resolution. The candidate will receive information in this respect after the date of announcing the results of the admissions.

- 2. Candidates admitted as students are required to provide:
- 1) a copy of the high school leaving certificate [A-Level] or a copy issued by OKE [Regional Examination Board], certified by the Academy of Fine Arts (the Dean's Office accepting the documents may certify the conformity of the photocopy provided that the original is presented) in the case of candidates admitted to a long-cycle studies or first-cycle studies;
- 2) a copy of the diploma certifying the degree of magister [master], licencjat [bachelor], inżynier [engineer] or an equivalent degree, certified by the Academy of Fine Arts, for candidates admitted to second-cycle studies. In case of lack of the diploma, it is acceptable to submit a certificate of studies, which includes information on the level, field of studies, and profile of studies, obtained degree, and the grade of studies in word. A person submitting a certificate is obligated to submit the diploma within 30 days of the date on which the diploma was issued under pain of being expelled from the list of students;
- 3) a medical certificate confirming that there are no contraindications to taking up studies in the chosen field of studies (referrals for medical examinations are issued by the Dean's Offices);
- 4) a declaration of readiness to take up studies at the Academy of Fine Arts as of October 1, 2022;
- 5) candidates who participated in the procedure for the confirmation of learning outcomes a photocopy of the decision of a relevant Committee.
- (3) In addition to the documents referred to in paragraph (2), persons admitted to courses taught in a foreign language shall be required to provide a document confirming their knowledge of the foreign language in which the course will be taught, as specified in the regulations issued pursuant to Article 47 of the Act of 21 November 2008 on the Civil Service (Journal of Laws of 2017, items 1889 and 2203, and of 2018, item 106).
